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Best Practice II

Title – Mobile Literary Campaign for Tribal Women

Objective –

- 1) To develop a mobile based literacy among hilly, Normadic, Tribal women in Kinwat Taluka.
- 2) To make them aware about android mobile, its use and benefits.
- 3) To educate them, so that these women can handle android phone for their daily based life.

Context –

The place Kinwat is situated in hilly, tribal, naxal affected region and the tribal women from village live in very remote areas so through modern technology this campaign is carried out for them by the students of the college to educate these tribal women about digital, mobile and computer knowledge. The students from any class are selected for the said task and encouraged to work for the people living in rural areas.

Practice –

This campaign is under taken by ICT department by dividing the said work among small groups of the students. If the students face any difficult in this work or if any training is needed, this department takes care of the matter. In every session this work is done and a report is prepared.

Evidence of success –

This training is carried out through the students in their residential village therefore they have no huddles while performing their work

Problem Encountered –

The main problem in the said campaign is that, most of the women don't have android phones and they have hesitation for using this kind of modern technology. At first they are afraid to handle mobile phones due to lack of knowledge, language proficiency etc. Some women are not willing to undergo this training and show negative approval for the same.

Notes :-

This kind of mobile literacy campaign should be implemented at the administrative level. At the same time, the university should suggest some colleges who come under tribal area to educate women in their areas. There might be large scope for digital literacy in such areas.
